At its 104th session (Madrid, 22–25 November 2016) the IOC Council of Members adopted the list of physico-chemical testing laboratories that meet the conditions for recognition specified in Decision No DEC-14/101-V/2013 of 29 November 2013.

I am therefore pleased to inform you that the laboratory of INNOVHUB – Stazioni Sperimentali per l'Industria, Area SSOG - Azienda Speciale della C.C.I.A.A. di Milano has been awarded IOC recognition for the period from 1 December 2016 to 30 November 2017. The pertinent certificate will be forwarded as soon as it is available.
